Please take a minute to read how the Woodmere Neighborhood Association (WNA) impacts your life and how your support makes a big difference. Joining together, each of us can make Woodmere a better place to live.

What has the WNA (in tandem with the city) done for you?

- Slowed down traffic on Woodmere Blvd. by installing 4 speed humps and 3 stop signs
- Increased your personal safety by installing multiple real-time traffic cameras connected directly to the police department to assist them in apprehending criminals, by installing street lights over the parking spaces at Woodmere Park, and by inviting a police officer to give us monthly and quarterly updates on crimes reported in Woodmere
- Improved the beauty and useability of Woodmere Park by repaving walking paths, by installing 3 park benches, and by maintaining fences and signs
- Improved the entrance to our neighborhood with 4 attractive entry signs and 2 flagpoles with U.S. flags
- Kept our residents informed with emailed newsletters, Facebook page, website, and quarterly meetings at the museum with guest speakers such as mayors, chiefs of police, state and county officials
- Responded to individual problems by filing 3-1-1 reports to enforce city ordinance codes
- Attended city council and city planning commission meetings to represent Woodmere in zoning cases.
